

PHOTOGRAPHY 2 PRESENTATIONS

You, yes you will be teaching the class one of these important concepts. Use Powerpoint or some other presentation program (Prezi, others?)

Include a lot of examples (at least 10. You can grab them from the Internet).

You need some way to evaluate how successful you are (test, quiz, question and answer period – you figure it out :) Welcome to my world :)

Be sure the presentation doesn't overwhelm the message. Do the letters really need to all spin and have some really loud sound effect? Does that help your audience better understand what you are trying to teach them or does it get in the way?

When you think you are done show it to me. I'll make suggestions. You will need to adjust, show it to me again, etc., until I think it is ready to present. The information needs to be what I consider accurate.

Topics

1 –Iso – Explain what it is, how you control it, show examples. Be sure to include pros and cons

2 –Shutterspeed – Explain what it is, how you control it, show examples of different shutterspeeds (fast, slow, panning, etc).

3 –Aperture – Explain what it is, how you control it, show examples of different apertures.

4 –Exposure– Explain what it is, how you control it, show examples. Be sure you cover what good and bad exposure is and looks like.

5 –Depth of Field – Explain what it is, how you control it, show examples

6 –Tv, Av, Manual – Explain what it is, how you control it, how do you know when you have achieved correct exposure in each of these modes.

7 –Other Shooting Modes – the different symbols on the dial other than: TV AV, MANUAL.

Explain what they are, when you would use them, show examples

8 –Exposure Compensation – Explain what it is, how you control it, show examples.

9 –Big Slide Show – Create a slide show that has a title slide that has one of the topics, at least ten examples, another title slide, at least ten examples, etc. We will look at this after everybody has done their presentations. Kind of a culminating thing. Include music.
